# What is the NRO-NC?

- NRO = Number Resource Organization
  - ▶ coordination between RIRs
- NRO-NC = NRO Number Council
  - ▶ Members are appointed/elected by the RIRs
  - ▶ <http://www.nro.net/about/number-council.html>

# What is the ASO-AC?

- ASO = Address Supporting Organization
  - ▶ One of the ICANN "Supporting Organizations"
- ASO-AC = ASO Address Council
  - ▶ Advises ICANN on number resource policy issues
  - ▶ <http://aso.icann.org/>



- In terms of an MoU between ICANN and the NRO, the NRO-NC fulfils the role, responsibility, and functions of the ASO-AC
  - ▶ <http://www.aso.icann.org/docs/aso-mou2004.html>
- Members are elected/appointed to the NRO-NC by the RIRs, and the same members also serve as the ICANN ASO-AC.

- 15 Members

- ▶ 3 from each RIR
- ▶ 2 elected by community
- ▶ 1 appointed by Board
- ▶ Typically serve three-year terms, but different RIRs have different procedures for electing or appointing members.

# Tasks of the ASO-AC

- Appoint seats 9 and 10 to ICANN Board of Directors
  - ▶ staggered three-year terms
- Serve on various ICANN bodies as needed
  - ▶ e.g. NomCom, Review Teams
- Process "Global Policy Proposals"
  - ▶ Assure ICANN Board that process has been followed
- Advise ICANN Board on number resources

- Seat 9: Ray Plzak
  - ▶ apointed mid-2009
  - ▶ re-appointed in 2012
  - ▶ serving until mid-2015
- Seat 10: Kuo-Wei Wu
  - ▶ appointed mid-2010
  - ▶ re-appointed mid-2013
  - ▶ serving until mid-2016



## Hans Petter Holen (RIPE region)

- was a member of the ASO-AC until 2013
- appointed by ASO-AC to ICANN 2014 NomCom

Fiona Asonga (Afrinic region)

- appointed by ASO-AC to ICANN ATRT2

# Advice re GPP-IPv4-2011 – Post Exhaustion IPv4 Allocation

- The ASO received a request for advice to IANA regarding the implementation of Global Policy for Post Exhaustion IPv4 Allocation Mechanisms by the IANA
- Consulted the policy forums in all regions
- Resulting advice was that the first allocation may take place as soon as the policy is triggered
- Subsequent allocations must be on six-month boundaries, as is clearly specified in the policy

# Triggering of GPP-IPv4-2011 – Post Exhaustion IPv4 Allocation

- On 20 May 2014, LACNIC's available pool of IPv4 space became less than a /9 equivalent.
- This triggered the activation of IANA's Recovered IPv4 Pool in terms of GPP-IPv4-2011
- IANA has made the first allocations to the RIRs from the recovered IPv4 pool
