







4. How to become Associate Member

AFRINIC has adopted in Jan 2013 a new bylaw that makes provision for associate membership. Associate members are members who do not receive Internet number resource services from AFRINIC, but join the organization to support and contribute to its overall mission.

Associate members will have the privilege to participate to AGMM and benefit some of the current and future services reserved to members beside number resources registration.

An associate member can be an Individual person, a corporate entity or an institution.



1, ibout 4. How to become Associate Member

To process a request for **Associate Membership** as quickly as possible, AFRINIC has set up the following procedures and steps with the aim of expediting the membership registration.

- 1. Fill in the online application
- 2. Evaluation of application by AFRINIC
- 3. Invoice Issued to the requestor by the AFRINIC Finance Team
- 4. Invoice Payment by the applicant
- 5. Associate Membership agreement signature the applicant then sent back to AFRINIC
- Associate Member Status Confirmation sent to the applicant by the Member Services Liaison Team

Please note that AFRINIC will work to complete any application within 15 working days. However the turnaround time taken to complete a registration would also depend on the time taken by the applicant to respond to the AFRINIC Registration Services Team. Page 14
