# ICANN alphabet soup



ICANN Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers
Performs the IANA function
IANA Internet Assigned Numbers Authority
Global coordination of root DNS, top level domains, IP addresses, AS numbers, port numbers, other protocol parameters
ICANN SO ICANN Supporting Organisation
ASO Address Supporting Organisation

ASO-AC ASO Address Council
Advises ICANN on number resource policy issues
Reviews global policies for number resources

# **RIR** alphabet soup



RIR Regional Internet Registry
AFRINIC, APNIC, ARIN, RIPE-NCC, LACNIC
Allocates IP addresses and AS numbers in a region
NRO Number Resource Organisation
Umbrella organisation formed by the five RIRs
Speaks with one voice, protect RIR interests
NRO-EC NRO Executive Council
Formed by the RIR boards, speaks on behalf of NRO
NRO-NC NRO Number Council
Reviews global policies for IP address management
Performs the functions of the ASO-AC

#### NRO-NC -vs- ASO-AC



The ASO is where the RIR system meets the ICANN system
 In terms of a Memorandum of Understanding between ICANN and the NRO:

 the NRO fulfils the role, responsibility, and functions of the ASO
 the NRO-NC fulfils the role, responsibility, and functions of the ASO-AC

 Members are elected/appointed to the NRO-NC by the RIRs
 The same members also serve, simultaneously, as the ICANN ASO-AC



# ASO-AC/NRO-NC Membership



15 Members
 3 from each of the five regions
 2 elected by RIR community
 1 appointed by RIR Board
 Typically serve three-year terms
 Different RIR's have different procedures for electing or appointing members

# Tasks of the ASO-AC



Appoint seats 9 and 10 to ICANN Board of Directors

 staggered three-year terms

 Appoint members to other ICANN bodies as needed

 e.g. Nomination Committee (NomCom), Review Teams
 Process Global Policy Proposals

 Assure ICANN Board that process has been followed
 Advise ICANN Board on number resource

appointed in 2009
re-appointed in 2012
serving until October 2015
Seat 10: Kuo-Wei Wu
appointed in 2010
re-appointed in 2013
serving until mid-2016
Seat 9 is up for re-appointment in 2015

Their mandate being to participate in developing accountability mechanisms important for the transition and after the transition



# **Global Policy Proposals**

A Global Policy is an Internet number resource policy that:
has been accepted by all five RIRs, and
requires action by IANA or another ICANN body
It must go through the policy development process in each region
Reviewed by the NRO-NC/ASO-AC
Ratified by the ICANN board
There are currently no global policy proposals on the table
